
Optimum balance

Bosch discovered what interpreters really want by exploring every possibility at length with the most respected conference interpreter's associations. Bosch initiated in-depth ergonomic studies and a series of workshops to determine the optimum balance between form, appearance and performance. Field trials of prototypes with seasoned interpreters yielded additional valuable input for refining the system even further.

The result is striking. Take the LCD screen as an example. It displays three lines of information simultaneously, giving interpreters an instant, at-a-glance overview of everything from incoming channels (with quality indication) and outgoing interpretations and messages to intercom calls and other relevant data.

Wide choice of relay channels

Each interpreter desk allows the pre-selection of up to five incoming channels. This gives a wide choice of relay channels. A 'speak slowly' button enables the interpreter to attract the attention of a delegate who is speaking too quickly. Incoming languages can be listened to through headphones or the built-in loudspeaker.




Intuitive operation

Considerable thought has gone into the positioning of every button and dial for comfortable, intuitive operation. This is especially appreciated by blind interpreters: by holding the unit in two hands, most of the functions can be operated using only the thumbs. An optional audible beep confirms that an action has been carried out.

High-fidelity sound standard

Bosch sets the new standard for high-fidelity sound with its 20 kHz of bandwidth for each channel. The performance of the desk will literally have hardworking interpreters talking. They will also enjoy a far more relaxing and efficient working environment.



Easy interfacing for maximum impact



Wireless distribution of 32 channels

The interpreter desk can be combined with the Integrus Wireless Infra-red Language Distribution System. This lets delegates choose any language from 32 crystal-clear channels without the constraint of connecting wires. Using a pocket-sized infra-red receiver and headphones, freedom of movement throughout the conference hall is guaranteed.

Wired distribution of 32 channels

Delegate positions can be easily equipped with wired, flush-mounted channel selector panels. This allows the selection of any of the interpretations or the floor language.

 The operator can view interpretation status and carry out channel assignments via a DCN software module.



Audio expansion

Interfacing with audio logging devices, public address installations and language distribution systems is easy with audio input/output units or audio expanders. These can even be located in nearby rooms or buildings and connect via fiber-optic cabling to the DCN Next Generation systems. This allows data transmission over relatively long distances without loss of information.

Flexible conference system design


Installation is extremely straightforward, a characteristic typical of all DCN equipment. Simply plug the interpreter desk into the system cabling (where it is automatically recognized), power it up, and it is effectively ready for use. At venues with multiple meeting rooms, where the number of interpretations required in each room can vary on a daily basis, additional interpreter desks can be easily added to supply extra language capacity.
